

# 'Winter Solstice'

a print by *Sabra Field*



The Vermont chapter of the American Society of Landscape Architects (ASLA) commissioned world-renowned Vermont printmaker *Sabra Field* to create a piece celebrating the beauty of Vermont's landscape.

Set during a snowy winter sunset, the print encapsulates the extent of the state's varied geography, from the Connecticut River on the eastern border to Lake Champlain on the west. The stylized and highly detailed view includes natural landmarks such as Camel's Hump, as well as Vermont's trademark rolling hills and countryside pastures. Field has also incorporated signs of humanity's influence on the land, including highways 89 and 91, and indicates settled areas through the use of small shimmering lights.

Profits from the sale of this limited edition, hand signed print support the efforts of three not for profit organizations dedicated to enhancing the Vermont landscape: the *Vermont Land Trust*, *Smart Growth Vermont*, and the *Vermont Chapter of the American Society of Landscape Architects*.
